Code of Ethics for Board Members

Code: Members of the Board of Directors of Indian Palms Country Club Association are committed to observing and promoting the highest standards of ethical conduct in the performance of their responsibilities on the board of IPCCA. Accountability

- 3. Fully disclose, at the earliest opportunity, a conflict of interest.

- 5. Remain accountable for prudent fiscal management to the association members and the rest of the board.

Professional Excellence

- 6. Maintain a professional level of courtesy, respect, and objectivity in all IPCCA activities and decisions.
- 7. Strive to uphold those practices and assist other IPCCA members of the board in upholding the highest standards of conduct.
- 8. Be diligent in the performance of your board responsibilities.

Personal Gain

9. Exercise the powers invested for the good of all members of the HOA, rather than for his or her personal benefit.

Equal Opportunity

- 10. Ensure the right of all association members to appropriate and effective services without discrimination based on geography, religious, or socio-economical characteristics.
- 11. Ensure the right of all association members to appropriate and effective services without discrimination based on the volunteer or staff make-up in respect to gender, sexual orientation, national origin, race, religion, age, political affiliation, or disability, in accordance with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

Confidential Information

12. Respect the confidentiality of sensitive information known due to board service.

Collaboration and Cooperation

- 13. Respect the diversity of opinions as expressed or acted upon by the IPCCA board, committees, and membership, and formally register dissent as appropriate.
- 14. Promote collaboration, cooperation, and partnership among committees, membership and your fellow board members.
