



## Indian Palms HOA



### TURF

**Mowing** – Mowing height will remain the same for the rest of the season.

**Fertilization** – No application scheduled for July.

**Herbicide** – Spot spraying for nutsedge



### SHRUBS

**Focus Pruning** – Heavy pruning will be avoided to prevent sun damage.

**Plant Replacement** – Replacements will be done per work order or special requests.



### TREES

**Scheduled Trimming** – Palm pruning was done in June.

### JULY 2021 HIGHLIGHTS

#### Notes:

\* July is a difficult month for landscape plants and workers. Long days and extreme heat are hard on most plants. Adequate irrigation is critical.

The rye grass from fall overseeding has mostly died off and turf areas are predominantly Bermuda grass. Bermuda does not grow well in the shade. Expect turf in shady areas to thin out or completely die. Watch for dry spots and correct irrigation problems as they appear. Continue to apply herbicide to control nutsedge.

Keep flower beds weeded and watch for pests.

Limit pruning heat sensitive shrubs. If shrubs are damaged by sun burn, do not remove damaged foliage until the weather cools.

Prune any palms that have not been pruned already.
