TURF

Mowing – Mowing height will remain the same until the over-seeding process begins.

Fertilization – No fertilization scheduled for the month of August.

Herbicide – Monument application to treat for nutsedge will be completed in August.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Normal maintenance pruning will be our focus and the avoidance of pruning heat sensitive shrubs.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacements will be done on a per work order basis with managers approval.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Palm pruning was completed in July. No pruning scheduled for August.

AUGUST 2021 HIGHLIGHTS

Notes:

* August is much the same as July. Hot, hot, hot. The landscape is in survival mode. Adequate irrigation is critical.

You may notice that turf in shady areas has thinned or is all dirt. Bermuda grass does not grow in shade, so as the winter rye dies in the heat, there is nothing left in these areas but dirt. These areas will remain unsightly until rye grass is overseeded in the fall.

Avoid heavy pruning of shrubs to prevent heat damage.

Begin planning for fall planting of annual flowers and overseeding.

Continue to treat nutsedge or broadleaf weeds in turf. Check for turf pests in areas that are not growing vigorously.
