TURF

Mowing – Overseeding will commence September 27th. One week prior to seeding we will be lowering the mowing height to .05” CVAG Smart scalping guide-lines will be followed for overseeding.

Fertilization – The next fertilization of turf will be after the first mowing of the new ryegrass.

Herbicide – No herbicide applications are scheduled for the month of October.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Shrubs that have been burned due to the high heat will be lightly trimmed of burned foliage as the temperature cool down.

Plant Replacement – Replacements for October will be done through service order process.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – We will begin tree pruning process early October and continue throughout the month until completely.

OCTOBER 2021 HIGHLIGHTS

Notes:

* October is the month of transformation in desert landscapes. The weather cools to ideal planting and growing temperatures. Plants are no longer stressed by the extreme heat of Summer.

Irrigation times and intervals will change to accommodate variables in weather and the needs of new plantings as they establish.

Lawns will be overseeded with ryegrass this month. Water will be reduced significantly as the grass is lowered in the weeks prior to seeding. Once the seed has been spread it must be kept wet. Irrigation will be set to run every couple of hours throughout the day. The new turf will be mowed in the third week after planting.

Annual flowers are usually planted this month. Pesticides may need to be applied to protect new plants.

October is an ideal month for planting projects.

Overgrown plants can now be pruned without having to worry about sunburn damage. Burned foliage from summer heat can be safely removed at this time. Shrubs can be fertilized to aid in recovery.
