TURF



Mowing – Mowing will be completed at a height of 1.5” and will remain the same throughout the winter season.

Fertilization – Fertilizer was applied after the first mowing.

* Fertilize turf areas to maintain color and vigor. As Bermuda goes dormant some brown spots may appear in overseeded turf. Apply rye seed and seed cover to these areas as they appear. Reduce irrigation as the weather cools. If there is ice on the grass do not walk or drive carts on it until the ice has melted or you will kill the grass.

Herbicide – There is no application of herbicide scheduled this month. Planter areas will be treated with Glyphosate as needed.

SHRUBS



Focus Pruning – Maintenance pruning will continue to be completed as needed. The structure of shrubs will continue to be natural not a balling or squaring shape.

*If cold sensitive plants are damaged by frost do not remove damaged foliage at this time. Plants commonly damaged by frost include Bougainvillea, Lantana, Hibiscus, Calliandra, and Carrissa. Limit pruning on these plants.

TREES



Scheduled Trimming – All tree pruning was completed in November.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: December brings consistently cool temperatures to the desert. The chance of freezing temperatures is possible throughout the month.
