

INDIAN PALMS HOA APRIL 2024

TURF



Mowing – Turf will be lowered to encourage the growth of Bermuda transition.

*Overseeded turfgrass will begin to have progressively more hot spots as temperatures rise and the turf transitions from ryegrass to bermudagrass. Fertilize to aid this transition. Apply herbicides to any nut sedge or broadleaf weeds that may appear.

Fertilization – Fertilizer will be applied starting mid-April until the end of the month.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds using herbicide will continue. Nutsedge treatment will commence this month.

SHRUBS



Focus Pruning – Heavier seasonal pruning is to be expected for optimal season of rapid and excessive growth.

* Prune shrubs to keep up with growth. Watch for pests on new growth and treat if necessary. This is still a good time for planting new shrubs.

TREES



Scheduled Trimming – A schedule has been made this month to start tree pruning.

* Monitor flower development on date palms and consider pruning when they have fully extended.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: April continues to be an ideal time for landscapes in the Coachella Valley. Temperatures are mild. Expect a lot of plant growth.
