### TURF



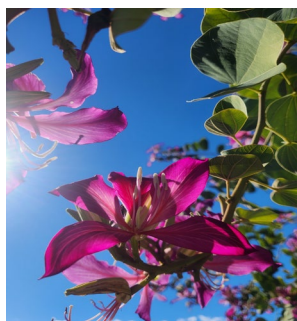
**Mowing** – One week prior to seeding mowing height will be lowered to .05”. Overseeding will start on October 3<sup>rd</sup>. CVAG guidelines will be followed during the overseeding process.

\*Turf overseeding will take place this month. Expect to see lower mowing heights and reduced watering before seeding rye grass. After seeding water will be increased to 5 - 6 times per day. Mowing new turf will begin in 2 - 3 weeks. Turf areas will be fertilized after mowing.

**Fertilization** – Fertilization will be done after the first mowing of the new grass.

**Herbicide** – “Glystar” (weed killer) will be sprayed as needed.

### SHRUBS



**Focus Pruning** – Sunburnt shrubs will be lightly trimmed and burnt foliage will be removed once temperatures begin to cool down.

\*This is a good month for pruning most plants and trees. If heavy pruning is needed, now is the time to do it. Fertilize shrubs to facilitate recovery from summer damage.

### TREES



**Scheduled Trimming** – Tree pruning will continue throughout the month until complete.
