

INDIAN PALMS HOA FEBRUARY 2025





Mowing – Mowing will be completed at the height of 1 ½".

*Pre-emergent herbicides should be applied to prevent crabgrass and broad leaf weeds.

Fertilization – Application of barricade fertilizer is scheduled mid-February to help prevent growth of weeds during the summertime.

Herbicide – Barricade pre-emergent will be applied as needed.

SHRUBS



Focus Pruning – Normal maintenance pruning will continue through the month. Pruning of frost damaged plants will be done if the weather permits.

*Any plants with frost damage foliage can be pruned back at the end of the month. This is also a good time for any heavy pruning that might need to be done. The end of the month is an optimal time for any spring planting.

TREES



Scheduled Trimming – No tree trimming is scheduled.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: February is usually the end of cold weather in the desert. By the end of the month there will be no chance of frost and springtime landscape activities can begin. Irrigation will need to increase as temperatures warm.
