



TURF

Mowing: Overseeding was completed last month. The first mowing will be completed at a height of 1 1/2" this month.

Fertilization: Fertilizer will be applied after the first cut.

Herbicide: Spraying is not scheduled this month.

General: Turf areas will be transitioning from summer Bermuda to Winter ryegrass. This process requires the gradual lowering of the existing turf to 1/2" and then overseeding with ryegrass. Irrigation will be reduced during the lowering process and then increased to 5 times per day for a couple of weeks while the seed is germinating.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Sunburnt shrubs will be lightly trimmed to remove foliage and avoid further damage.

Herbicide: Spraying will continue to be completed for weeds in shrub beds.

General: Now is still a good time for any heavy pruning before the weather gets colder next month. This is still a good time for all types of new planting projects.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: No tree trimming is scheduled.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: November continues with ideal temperatures for landscapes. November is usually a good month for most landscape projects.
