



TURF

Mowing: Mowing will be completed at a height of 1.5" and will remain at that height throughout the winter season.

Fertilization: Fertilizer was applied after the first mowing.
Herbicide: Not scheduled for turf, but will be applied to planters. More information will be provided on the herbicide schedule.

General: Overseeded turf areas should be filled in, and ryegrass should be established. If there is frost on turf, do not walk or drive on frost areas, or damage will occur. Watch for areas that were not filled in with ryegrass as the Bermuda goes dormant and turns brown. Apply seed and seed cover to these areas as they appear. Fertilize turf to keep good color and vigor as temperatures drop.

SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Maintenance pruning will continue to be completed as needed.

General: Limit shrub pruning for the next couple of months to minimize frost damage to plants. If damage occurs do not remove damaged foliage at this time. Do not plant frost sensitive plants until March.

TREES

Scheduled Pruning: No tree trimming is scheduled.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: December is the month when there is a chance of significant cold weather. There is a good chance that there could be freezing temperatures and frost related damage to sensitive plants.
