



## TURF

**Mowing:** Mowing will continue to be completed at a normal height.

**Herbicide:** Rye grass will continue to decline due to the warmer weather. Dead spots are expected to remain as Bermuda grass establishes itself. Herbicides will be applied as need to control nutsedge and other weeds.

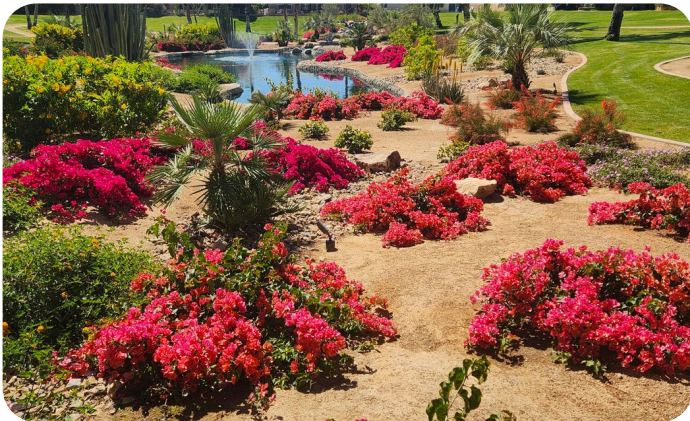
**General:** Turf areas will be transitioned to Bermuda by the end of the month. Expect some hot spots during this transition. Spray nutsedge and broadleaf weeds as they appear.



## SHRUBS

**Focus Pruning:** Pruning will be performed on shrubs to manage rapid growth.

**General:** Limit pruning on heat-sensitive plants. If plants get sunburned, do not remove damaged foliage or risk creating more damage.



## TREES

**Scheduled Pruning:** Washingtonia Palms are scheduled for pruning the last week of May through the first week of June.

## HIGHLIGHTS

**Notes:** June typically begins the summer season with the possibility of extreme temperatures. Irrigation requirements may change significantly this month. Monitor current forecast and make changes as necessary.
