



TURF

Mowing: The mowing height will be lowered to encourage the growth of Bermuda transition.

Fertilization: Application of fertilizer began in late April and will continue through May.

Herbicide: Spot spraying will continue to be done for broadleaf weeds. Nutsedge treatment is scheduled to begin this month.

General: Turf areas will be in full transition. Watch for hot spots and make irrigation corrections as necessary. Apply herbicides for nutsedge or broadleaf weeds if present. Fertilize to promote Bermuda growth. Drop mowing heights to best manage Bermuda.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Heavier seasonal pruning will be completed; this is the optimal season to do so since rapid growth is expected.

General: As temperatures increase, reduce pruning and planting heat-sensitive plants.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: Tree pruning will be completed per schedule.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: May is the last month before the extreme temperatures of summer. There is a chance of 100+ degree temperatures, so keep an eye on the weather forecast.
