



TURF

Mowing: The height of mowing will remain the same for the rest of the season.

Herbicide: Monument and Speedzone will be applied for nutsedge control.

General: Bermuda turf should be filled in and at its peak except in shady areas where there may be significant lack of turf. Treat nutsedge and other weeds as they appear.

SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Normal maintenance pruning will be performed, while heat-sensitive shrubs will be left unpruned to prevent damage.

Herbicide: T-nex will be applied to the turf to regulate grass growth and reduce mowing frequency.

General: Limit shrub pruning to prevent heat related damage to plants. New plantings should be put off until next month if possible.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: All palm tree pruning was completed last month.



HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: August continues the period of extreme temperatures in the Coachella Valley. Landscape plants and workers will remain under stress throughout this month. Adequate irrigation will continue to be vital to preventing plant damage.
